The End-Time Generation

In the Bible are many things, which may seem to be contradictions to the natural worldly mind. Of course we believe that the Bible is true from cover to cover by faith. We believe that the Bible is God's Word to man, and does not contain any contradictions.

I want to examine just one of these so-called contradictions, which the worldly, natural wisdom says is in the Bible.

Matthew 1:17 " So all the generations from Abraham to David are fourteen generations; and from David until the carrying away into Babylon are fourteen generations; and from the carrying away into Babylon unto Christ are fourteen generations".

In this passage we find that from Abraham to Christ there are said to be 42 generations, but if you count the names up there are only 41!! There does in fact seem to be a contradiction. There are 3 possibilities

1. Matthew got It wrong.
2. The translators got it wrong.
3. Or there is no contradiction! God put it there for an important reason!

Can we learn anything from a dry list of names? I think we can.

(Proverbs 25:2 AV). "It is the glory of God to conceal a thing: but the honour of kings is to search out a matter". Lets do a bit of Investigation.

Matthew 27:46 " My God, my God, why hast thou forsaken me?"

Why did Jesus speak these words when He was on the cross? Our religious mind tells us that God had forsaken Him.

But to the Jews of His day it meant far more than what we think it meant. The Jewish New Testament commentary has this note under this verse. "In Judaism, when a Old Testament verse is quoted, Its entire context is implied"

Jesus was quoting the first verse of Psalm 22, what Jesus was saying to those who have ears to hear, was all of Psalm 22, and relates to Him!

Psalm 22 as long been recognised as being a prophetic word about the death of Jesus on the Cross and written by David 1,000 years before it happened.

Verse 1 -18 gives a graphic description of what Jesus endured on The

Cross:

" My God, my God, why hast thou forsaken me? Why art thou so far from helping me, and from the words of my roaring? O my God, I cry in the daytime, but thou hearest not; and in the night season, and am not silent. But thou art holy, O thou that inhabitant the praises of Israel. Our fathers trusted in thee: they trusted, and thou didst deliver them. They cried unto thee, and were delivered: they trusted in thee, and were not confounded. (6) But I am a worm, and no man; a reproach of men, and despised of the people. All they that see me laugh me to scorn: they shoot out the lip, they shake the head, saying, He trusted on the LORD that he would deliver him: let Him deliver him, seeing He delighted in him. But Thou art He that took me out of the womb: Thou didst make me hope when I was upon my mother's breasts. I was cast upon Thee from the womb: Thou art my God from my mother's belly. Be not far from me; for trouble is near; for there is none to help. (12) Many bulls have compassed me: strong bulls of Bashan have beset me round. They gaped upon me with their mouths, as a ravening and a roaring lion. I am poured out like water, and all my bones are out of joint: my heart is like wax; it is melted in the midst of my bowels, tell all my bones. My strength is dried up like a potsherd; and my tongue cleaveth to my jaws; and Thou hast brought me into the dust of death. For dogs have compassed me: the assembly of the wicked have enclosed me: they pierced my hands

and my feet. I may tell my bones: they look and stare upon me. They part my garments among them, and cast lots upon my vesture. (Psalms 22:1-18 AV)

Verses 19,20 and the first part of Verse 21 are the cries of Jesus for help:

" But be not Thou far from Me, O LORD: O my strength, haste Thee to help me. Deliver my soul from the sword; my darling from the power of the dog. Save me from the lion's mouth"

Did God hear Jesus or did He forsake Him? The last part of verse 21 gives us the answer: "For Thou hast heard me from the horns of the unicorns."
(Psalms 22:19-21 AV)

Verse 24 goes on to say " For He hath not despised nor abhorred the affliction of the afflicted; neither hath He hid His face from him; but when he cried unto Him, He heard " (Psalms 22:24 AV)

The rest of the Psalm is praise, but drop down to verses 30 & 31 and we will get our first clue to the identity of the missing generation:

Psalm 22:30-31 " A seed shall serve Him; it shall be accounted to the Lord for a generation".

"They shall come, and shall declare His righteousness unto a people that shall be born, that He hath done this".

Notice that there will be a Seed, which will be accounted to The Lord for a Generation. But also notice what they will do "Declare His Righteousness unto a People that shall be born".

In other words this prophecy was for the future, I believe that this was why Jesus was quoting this Psalm, I believe that this refers to the End-Time Generation that God is going to rise up now.

When it comes to prophecy most Christians see the Rapture as a means of escaping the wrath of God, which will be poured out. I don't believe that we will be raptured like that. I believe that we will be raptured because; the battles over and we have won!!

I remember a Hymn that we used to sing. It starts like this:

"Ho, my Comrades see the signal waving in the sky. Ho, my Comrades see the signal, Victory is nigh"

It that sounds very good doesn't it? But wait till you hear the start of verse 2:

"See the mighty host advancing, Satan leading on"

Yes you heard it right, That's what it says. That is why many Christians want the rapture to come, because they are afraid of Satan, and don't want to fight him.

I have got news for you my Jesus is not returning for losers, but winners, not the defeated, but the victorious.

We are the generation that will see Jesus return for a Church in Victory.

Many well meaning Christians, even those who specialise in prophecy, don't believe that there will be a End-Time Revival, they will tell you that there are no prophecies to be fulfilled before Jesus returns, that He could come at any time. I used to believe that, but my Bible tells me that Jesus is returning, for a Church "without Spot or Wrinkle".

Ephesians 5:27 " That He might present it to Himself a glorious church, not having spot, or wrinkle, or any such thing; but that it should be holy and without blemish." (Ephesians 5:27 AV)

While I believe that The Generation that David prophesied about is part

of the Church in the last days, I don't believe that all Christians will be part of this missing generation. We all have free will, and to be part of this generation will require total commitment! Yes those who are not prepared to make that commitment will still be saved, but they won't share the rewards of those who do.

Go back to Psalm 22:31 "and shall declare His righteousness unto a people that shall be born, that He hath done this".

One translation translates "He Hath done this" as "It is Finished".

Why is it finished? Because we are the last generation, time is running out.

I believe that we have found the missing Generation of Matthew 1:27, in Matthew 27:46, and in Psalm 22. However that is only the beginning of our quest.

Isaiah 53:8-10 "He was taken from prison and from judgement: and who shall declare his generation? For he was cut off out of the land of the living: for the transgression of my people was he stricken. And he made his grave with the wicked, and with the rich in his death; because he had done no violence, neither was any deceit in his mouth. Yet it pleased the

LORD to bruise him; he hath put him to grief: when thou shalt make his soul an offering for sin, he shall see his seed, he shall prolong his days, and the pleasure of the LORD shall prosper in his hand.

What does it mean, "To be cut off from the land of the living? It is a Jewish idiom meaning "To die Childless". There would be no one to declare His Generation, Isaiah thought".

Psalm 127:3,4 "Children are an heritage of the LORD: and the fruit of the womb is his reward. As arrows are in the hand of a mighty man; so are children of the youth. Happy is the man that hath his quiver full of them: they shall not be ashamed, but they shall speak with the enemies in the gate". Notice that it brought shame in the Old Testament "To go childless".

(Hebrews 12:2 AV) " Looking unto Jesus the author and finisher of our faith; who for the joy that was set before him endured the cross, despising the shame, and is set down at the right hand of the throne of God".

Why does it say that Jesus despised the shame?

Because going to the Cross produced His Seed That is Why He said, "A corn of wheat must fall into the ground and die to produce fruit"!! (Isaiah

53:10) "He shall see his seed, he shall prolong his days, and the pleasure of the LORD shall prosper in his hand".

Isaiah must have wondered at the paradox of what God told him to say "and who shall declare his generation? For he was cut off out of the land of the living": but in the future, the messiah was going to see His seed.

Isaiah 61:9 " And their seed shall be known among the Gentiles, and their offspring among the people: all that see them shall acknowledge them, that they are the seed which the LORD hath blessed "

Here we find who the seed are or who are the missing Generation. Notice, that they will be known among the Gentiles. "Gentiles means Nations", this generation will have a worldwide ministry.

The People mean, "Ones own people" or "Kindred". We already have a worldwide ministry but this verse says that if we are part of this lost End-Time Generation; we will have a Great ministry in this nation, to our own people.

They are going to acknowledge who the seed is.

Acknowledge means "To recognise, acknowledge, know, pay attention to, pay regard to, notice, acknowledge with honour, to be acquainted with, to understand".

The heathen are going to pay attention to His Seed, The Missing generation. They are going to understand what they say; they are going to recognise just who the seed is and, acknowledge them with honour.

Isaiah 54; 1-4 "Sing, O barren, thou that didst not bear; break forth into singing, and cry aloud, thou that didst not travail with child: for more are the children of the desolate than the children of the married wife, saith the LORD. Enlarge the place of thy tent, and let them stretch forth the curtains of thine habitations: spare not, lengthen thy cords, and strengthen thy stakes; For thou shalt break forth on the right hand and on the left; and thy seed shall inherit the Gentiles, and make the desolate cities to be inhabited. Fear not; for thou shalt not be ashamed: neither be thou confounded; for thou shalt not be put to shame: for thou shalt forget the shame of thy youth, and shalt not remember the reproach of thy widowhood any more."

What will be the ministry of this missing Generation?

Isaiah 61:1-4 "The Spirit of the Lord GOD is upon me; because the LORD hath anointed me to preach good tidings unto the meek; he hath sent me to bind up the broken-hearted, to proclaim liberty to the captives, and the opening of the prison to them that are bound; To proclaim the acceptable year of the LORD, and the day of vengeance of our God; to comfort all that mourn; To appoint unto them that mourn in Zion, to give unto them beauty for ashes, the oil of joy for mourning, the garment of praise for the spirit of heaviness; that they might be called trees of righteousness, the planting of the LORD, that he might be glorified. And they shall build the old wastes, they shall raise up the former desolation's, and they shall repair the waste cities, the desolation's of many generations".

Let's carry on reading because in verse 10 and 11, we find that instead of speaking about the Seed as them, in these verses the Seed speak of themselves as 'I'.

Isaiah 61:10 "I will greatly rejoice in the LORD, my soul shall be joyful in my God; for he hath clothed me with the garments of salvation, he hath covered me with the robe of righteousness, as a bridegroom decketh himself with ornaments, and as a bride adorneth herself with her jewels".

The Seed, the generation that was lost, are covered with a Robe of Righteousness, They are like a bride covered with jewels, do those verses ring

any bells?

Isaiah 61:11 "For as the earth bringeth forth her bud, and as the garden causeth the things that are sown in it to spring forth; so the Lord GOD will cause righteousness and praise to spring forth before all the nations".

God says that it is springtime, its time for the bud to bring forth, it's time for the seed to germinate and grow. God says that Righteousness and praise are going to spring forth. The words "Spring forth" are one word in Hebrew meaning "To Grow Abundantly", not a few ears of corn here and there, but a great harvest!

1 Peter 2:9 "But ye are a chosen generation, a royal priesthood, an holy nation, a peculiar people; that ye should shew forth the praises of him who hath called you out of darkness into his marvellous light".

Now I know that this verse is speaking about the position of every born again believer, lets get real the Church has never experienced this verse in its fullness.

Chosen means, "Picked out, Chosen". The root meaning is "Choice, Select, i.e. the best of its kind or class, excellence, pre-eminent: applied to certain individual Christians".

This End-time Generation will be the very best of The God kind. I believe that this verse in its fullness is speaking about the End-Time Generation, the Seed that we have been trying to trace throughout the Word. The root of the Greek word Translated Generation has some very interesting meanings:

"To become, i.e. to come into existence, begin to be, receive being .To arise, appear in history, to come upon the stage. To be made, or finished of miracles, to be performed, wrought. To become, be made"

We can see from this verse that the generation referred to here, comes into being at a special time in history. Their mission is to perform Miracles. We are in the time in history when they will be revealed!

Isaiah 43:5-7 "Fear not: for I am with thee: I will bring thy seed from the east, and gather thee from the west; I will say to the north, Give up; and to the south, Keep not back: bring my sons from far, and my daughters from the ends of the earth; Even every one that is called by my name: for I have created him for my glory, I have formed him; yea, I have made him".

God says that we are not to be afraid that this might not happen, He has given His Word that in the Last - Days, He will bring revival to His Church, and that multitudes of people will come to know Him as Saviour and Lord. He has said that He will do it, and is bound by His Word.

Psalm 102:12-21 "But thou, O LORD, shalt endure for ever; and thy remembrance unto all generations. 13 Thou shalt arise, and have mercy upon Zion: for the time to favour her, yea, the set time, is come. (God is going to Arise, Yes, but it will be through His End-Time People The Lost Generation. The Church today is the Zion of God. We are Jerusalem. God has 'Set a Time' to do this) 14 for thy servants take pleasure in her stones, and favour the dust thereof. 15 So the heathen shall fear the name of the LORD, and all the kings of the earth thy glory. (Fear should read revere) 16 When the LORD shall build up Zion, he shall appear in his glory. (Whom is the Lord going to appear in? Zion, His people). 17 He will regard the prayer of the destitute, and not despise their prayer. 18 This shall be written for the generation to come: and the people which shall be created shall praise the LORD. 19 For he hath looked down from the height of his sanctuary; from heaven did the LORD behold the earth; 20 To hear the groaning of the prisoner; to loose those that are appointed to death; 21 To declare the name of the LORD in Zion, and his praise in Jerusalem.

There are a couple of cross-references to verse 21 that are very important.

Psalm 22:22," I will declare thy name unto my brethren: in the midst of the congregation will I praise thee".

Hebrew 2:11-13 " For both he that sanctifieth and they who are sanctified are all of one: for which cause he is not ashamed to call them brethren, Saying, I will declare thy name unto my brethren, in the midst of the church will I sing praise unto thee. And again, I will put my trust in him. And again, Behold I and the children which God hath given me".

God Gave Jesus a Seed or Children, and because of this fact, He is going to Declare God's name and He is going to sing praises in the Church. How is Jesus going to declare God's Name? How is He going to sing praises? The Church is His Body on the earth; He will do it through them. A generation of people is about to come forth, who will do this, and they will declare His name with power, and bring many into the kingdom.

Isaiah 8:18 " Behold, I and the children whom the LORD hath given me are for signs and for wonders in Israel from the LORD of hosts, which dwelleth in mount Zion".

"Sign", means "Sign, or Signal, A Distinguishing Mark, A Miraculous Sign, A Miracle or proof. A Warning.

"Wonder", means "A special display of God's power".

Jesus Himself was a Sign and a Wonder to Israel; His end-time generation will be a sign and a wonder in the Church and to the world. We all long to see "Signs and Wonders". God has promised that we will, but will only be manifested by the Lost Generation, those who are the Seed of Christ.

You may say that Jesus had no Children. However that is not what God's Word says:

Isaiah 9:6 "For unto us a child is born, unto us a son is given: and the government shall be upon his shoulder: and his name shall be called Wonderful, Counsellor, The mighty God, The everlasting Father, The Prince of Peace".

Jesus was not just the one born of a virgin, He was not just the Prince of Peace, He was not just the Wonderful Counsellor, He is also, The Everlasting Father! To be a Father He must have Children.

Rev 1:7,8 " Behold, he cometh with clouds; and every eye shall see him, and they also which pierced him: and all kindred of the earth shall wail because of him. Even so, Amen. I am Alpha and Omega, the beginning and the ending, saith the Lord, which is, and which was, and which is to come, the Almighty". Who is Alpha and Omega? Jesus Christ".

Rev 21:6,7 " And he said unto me, it is done. I am Alpha and Omega, the beginning and the end. I will give unto him that is athirst of the fountain of the water of life freely. He that overcometh shall inherit all things; and I will be his God, and he shall be my son."

Who are the Sons of Jesus Christ? The Overcomes. Who is the Missing Generation? The Overcomes of Revelation.

Abraham's Seed

Gal 3:16 " Now to Abraham and his seed were the promises made. He saith not, And to seeds, as of many; but as of one, And to thy seed, which is Christ. Gal 3:26"For ye are all the children of God by faith in Christ Jesus". Gal 3: 29 "And if ye be Christ's, then are ye Abraham's seed, and heirs according to the promise".

There does seem to be a contradiction here. How can the one seed of

Abraham become many in verse 16, become many in verse 29?

If I take 2 packets of seed, one containing a mixture of Carrot, Radish and Watermelon, and another packet containing only Wheat, Which packet can be said to contain one Seed?

The Wheat of course, because all the seeds are identical! It's not one seed, but one variety of seed!

The Seed of Jesus Christ which is about to be manifest, Our missing Generation, have His nature in them, but unlike all previous generations they will allow that the Life which is in the Seed to come forth.

John 12:24 "Verily, verily, I say unto you, except a corn of wheat fall into the ground and die, it abideth alone: but if it die, it bringeth forth much fruit".

Isaiah 54; 1-4 "Sing, O barren, thou that didst not bear; break forth into singing, and cry aloud, thou that didst not travail with child: for more are the children of the desolate than the children of the married wife, saith the LORD. Enlarge the place of thy tent, and let them stretch forth the curtains of thine habitations: spare not, lengthen thy cords, and strengthen thy stakes; For thou shalt break forth on the right hand and on the

left; and thy seed shall inherit the Gentiles, and make the desolate cities to be inhabited. Fear not; for thou shalt not be ashamed: neither be thou confounded; for thou shalt not be put to shame: for thou shalt forget the shame of thy youth, and shalt not remember the reproach of thy widowhood any more." (Isaiah 54:1-4 AV)

Summary

In the last days a group of people will come forth. Who will display the power of God in a way that has never been know to man? They will not just display Signs and Wonders, but they themselves will be Signs and Wonders.

These people are known in the Book of Revelation, as "The Overcomes". They are "The Seed" who were to be accounted to the Lord for a Generation (Psalm 22:30)

They are the glorious Church of Ephesians.

However this generation will not be the entire Church, but only they who have committed 100% to Him:

Those who have put on the mind of Christ. Those who think like Him.
Those who are walking 100% in the Spirit. Those who have put to death,
the old nature, and put on the new. Those who are prepared to do what
ever He asks; to go wherever He sends them.

The Glory of Gods End-time Church

Habakkuk 2: 14

14 "For the earth shall be filled with the knowledge of the glory of the LORD, as the waters cover the sea".

Psalms 72:19

19 "And blessed be his glorious name forever: and let the whole earth be filled with his glory; Amen, and Amen".

Isaiah 11:9

9 "They shall not hurt nor destroy in all my holy mountain: for the earth shall be full of the knowledge of the LORD, as the waters cover the sea".

" with the knowledge of the glory". Margin "by knowing the glory"

Joel 2:19-32

19 "Yea, the LORD will answer and say unto his people, Behold, I will send you corn, and wine, and oil, and ye shall be satisfied therewith: and I will no more make you a reproach among the heathen:

20 But I will remove far off from you the northern army, and will drive him into a land barren and desolate, with his face toward the east sea, and his hinder part toward the utmost sea, and his stink shall come up, and his ill savour shall come up, because he hath done great things.

21 Fear not, O land; be glad and rejoice: for the LORD will do great things.

22 Be not afraid, ye beasts of the field: for the pastures of the wilderness do spring, for the tree beareth her fruit, the fig tree and the vine do yield their strength.

23 Be glad then, ye children of Zion, and rejoice in the LORD your God: for he hath given you the former rain moderately, and he will cause to come down for you the rain, the former rain, and the latter rain in the first month.

24 And the floors shall be full of wheat, and the fats shall overflow with wine and oil.

25 And I will restore to you the years that the locust hath eaten, the cankerworm, and the caterpillar, and the palmerworm, my great army which I sent among you.

26 And ye shall eat in plenty, and be satisfied, and praise the name of the LORD your God, that hath dealt wondrously with you: and my people shall never be ashamed.

27 And ye shall know that I am in the midst of Israel, and that I am the LORD your God, and none else: and my people shall never be ashamed.

28 And it shall come to pass afterward, that I will pour out my spirit upon all flesh; and your sons and your daughters shall prophesy, your old men shall dream dreams, your young men shall see visions:

29 And also upon the servants and upon the handmaids in those days will I pour out my spirit.

30 And I will shew wonders in the heavens and in the earth, blood, and fire, and pillars of smoke.

31 The sun shall be turned into darkness, and the moon into blood, before the great and the terrible day of the LORD come.

32 And it shall come to pass, that whosoever shall call on the name of the LORD shall be delivered: for in mount Zion and in Jerusalem shall be deliverance, as the LORD hath said, and in the remnant whom the LORD shall call”.

(KJV)

I am looking Forward to the Day these scriptures are fulfilled; I believe it will be in our lifetime.

Why have we not seen this yet? I believe that it is because the Church does not think it is worthy!

Romans 2:23

23 “For all have sinned, and come short of the glory of God;”

The Majority of born again Christians don't know that they are righteous. They believe that they still fall short of the Glory of God.

Romans 5:17,21

17 "For if by one man's offence death reigned by one; much more they which receive abundance of grace and of the gift of righteousness shall reign in life by one, Jesus Christ.

21 That as sin hath reigned unto death, even so might grace reign through righteousness unto eternal life by Jesus Christ our Lord".
(KJV)

Romans 10:10

10 "For with the heart man believeth unto righteousness; and with the mouth confession is made unto salvation".

2 Corinthians 5:21

21 "For he hath made him to be sin for us, who knew no sin; that we might be made the righteousness of God in him".

I believe the fact that the majority of Christians believe that they are 'Sinners who fall short of Gods Glory' it has coloured there thinking regarding the end time Revival, which God has promised to send to the Church.

They are looking for a great falling away! Based on **2 Thess 2:3**

3 "Let no man deceive you by any means: for that day shall not come, except there come a falling away first, and that man of sin be revealed, the son of perdition;"

The Greek does not Say 'Falling away', but 'Catching away'. It refers to the rapture of the Church.

It is after the rapture of the Church that the Anti-christ will be revealed.

Lets look at **Romans 3:23** in its context:

21 But now the righteousness of God without the law is manifested, being witnessed by the law and the prophets;

22 Even the righteousness of God, which is by faith of Jesus Christ unto all and upon all them that believe: for there is no difference:

23 For all have sinned, and come short of the glory of God;

24 Being justified freely by his grace through the redemption that is in Christ Jesus:

25 Whom God hath set forth to be a propitiation through faith in his blood, to declare his righteousness for the remission of sins that are past, through the forbearance of God;

26 To declare, I say, at this time his righteousness: that he might be just, and the justifier of him which believeth in Jesus”.

The whole passage is about the believer’s righteousness, not sin.

Because we fell short of Gods glory, God sent Jesus and we don’t fall short any more.

Lets look at some scriptures, which promises us Glory.

2 Peter 1:3,4

3 According as his divine power hath given unto us all things that pertain unto life and godliness, through the knowledge of him that hath called us to glory and virtue:

4 Whereby are given unto us exceeding great and precious promises: that by these ye might be partakers of the divine nature, having escaped the corruption that is in the world through lust.

Verse 3 tells us we have been ‘Called to Glory’

Called = Greek root = ‘Order or Commandment’.

1 Peter 2:9

9 “But ye are a chosen generation, a royal priesthood, an holy nation, a peculiar people; that ye should show forth the praises of him who hath called you out of darkness into his marvellous light:”

What is His Marvellous Light to which we have been called? It is ‘The Glory of God’.

2 Corinthians 4:6,7

6 "For God, who commanded the light to shine out of darkness, hath shined in our hearts, to give the light of the knowledge of the glory of God in the face of Jesus Christ.

7 But we have this treasure in earthen vessels, that the excellency of the power may be of God, and not of us".

Right now the Glory is on the inside of you. God calls it Treasure.

I am reminded of the story of Gideon in the Old Testament.

At the time Gideon lived Israel was under occupation by the midianites.

God told Israel through Gideon that they where to carry a flaming torch, concealed in a clay pot, in one hand and a sword in the other.

Gideon had only 100 men against all the host of Midian.

When the word was given, the Army of Gideon, was to brake the jar revealing the light, and go into battle.

In the ensuing battle the host of Middian was routed.

We have the light of God, His Glory inside us. We are the earthen vessels God is going to use in this generation to route the enemy, the devil, and all his hordes of demons.

Col 1:25-27

25 Whereof I am made a minister, according to the dispensation of God which is given to me for you, to fulfil the word of God;

26 Even the mystery which hath been hid from ages and from generations, but now is made manifest to his saints:

27 To whom God would make known what is the riches of the glory of this mystery among the Gentiles; which is Christ in you, the hope of glory:

This is part of Paul's prayer for the believers. Paul prayed 'that we may know the mystery of the Glory.

The Mystery according to Paul is '**That Christ is in us, therefore we have the Hope of Glory**'

The word Hope in Greek means '**joyful expectation**'.

Because Christ is in us we should joyfully expect to see the Glory manifest or be revealed so that the world may see it.

We should get excited about it. Revival is coming. Signs and Wonders; healings are about to be manifest in a way that is unprecedented.

God's power is about to be poured out in a way that we have not seen since the days of the early Church.

Eph 1:15-18

15 Wherefore I also, after I heard of your faith in the Lord Jesus, and love unto all the saints,

16 Cease not to give thanks for you, making mention of you in my prayers;

17 That the God of our Lord Jesus Christ, the Father of glory, may give unto you the spirit of wisdom and revelation in the knowledge of him:

18 The eyes of your understanding being enlightened; that ye may know what is the hope of his calling, and what the riches of the glory of his inheritance in the saints,

Paul says a number of things in this prayer:

1. **God is the Father of Glory.** Therefore we are Children of Glory.
2. **We need a Revelation of who He is,** so that we may know who we are.
3. **The Glory is the Hope of our Calling,** therefore we should joyfully expect to see it in manifestation.
4. **The Glory is our inheritance. Proverbs 3:33** says that '**The wise will inherit glory**'

Psalm 84:11,12

11 For the LORD God is a sun and shield: the LORD will give grace and glory: no good thing will he withhold from them that walk uprightly.

**12 O LORD of hosts, blessed is the man that trusteth in thee.
(KJV)**

In teaching about prosperity this verse is quoted a lot. But notice what is promised 'Grace and Glory'.

God says He will not withhold the Glory. God is a giving God. The Glory is a good thing.

There is one condition however 'walk uprightly', we are righteous by nature, but God says 'We have to walk in it', to see his glory manifest.

In other words we have to do, what we are. Our conduct must match our confession.

Psalm 85:8-11

8 I will hear what God the LORD will speak: for he will speak peace unto his people, and to his saints: but let them not turn again to folly.

9 Surely his salvation is nigh them that fear him; that glory may dwell in our land.

10 Mercy and truth are met together; righteousness and peace have kissed each other.

11 Truth shall spring out of the earth; and righteousness shall look down from heaven.

The purpose of Salvation according to verse 9 is 'that salvation may dwell in our land'

9 Surely his salvation is nigh them that fear him; that glory may dwell in our land.

Psalm 102:12-22

12 But you, o Lord, will abide forever; Your renown endures to all generations.

13 You will arise and have mercy on Zion; For it is time to have pity on her. Yes, the set time has come.

14 For your servants take pleasure in her stones, And have pity on her dust.

15 So the nations will fear the name of Yahweh; All the kings of the earth your glory.

16 When the Lord builds up Zion. He will appear in his glory.

17 He has responded to the prayer of the destitute, And has not despised their prayer.

18 This will be written for the generation to come. A people which will be created will praise The Lord.

19 For he has looked down from the height of his sanctuary. From heaven, The Lord saw the earth;

20 To hear the groans of the prisoner; To free those who are condemned to death;

21 That men may declare the name of The Lord in Zion, And his praise in Jerusalem;

22 When the peoples are gathered together, The kingdoms, to serve The Lord.

Lets look at these verses.

- 1. The Church is Spiritual Zion. Gods New covenant Chosen people.**
- 2. There is a set time to favour Zion. It is that time now.**
- 3. This Psalm was written for a Generation to come. We are that Generation.**
- 4. When The Lord builds up Zion, He will appear in Glory.** The problem with The Church today, is that it is by and large built up by

man. To see the glory manifest, we need for God to build up the Church, not man.

When the Church allows God to be God and do things His way, His Glory will manifest.

Galatians 5:26 Tells us

26 Not be desirous of vain glory,

(KJV)

Let us not be full of self-glory,

(BBE)

Isaiah 48:11

"I will not give my glory unto another."

God is the only source of Glory. Mans glory like mans righteousness, is to God like filthy rags.

The instant you begin looking at a man, the Glory will cease to manifest. That man may be a great singer or preacher, but he cannot give you the Glory.

The Glory demands that all attention and focus be placed upon God.

5. He Will create a people to bring in His Glory. We are Gods New Creation.

1 Peter 2:9

9 But you are a chosen generation, a royal priesthood, a holy nation, a people for possession, so that you might speak of the praises of Him who has called you out of darkness into His marvellous light;

6. He responds to the prayer of the destitute. Why does God? Say that he responds to the destitute?

In Matthew 5:3 Jesus said: "Blessed are the poor in spirit: for theirs is the kingdom of heaven".

Does this mean that God blesses spiritual poverty?

No the poor in Spirit are those who do not rely on their own strength, but are totally dependent on Him.

7. The purpose of the glory. That men may declare the name of The Lord in Zion, And his praise in Jerusalem;

In other words the purpose of the outpouring of the Glory, is that People get born-again and Spirit filled.

Isaiah 40:5

"And the glory of the LORD shall be revealed, and all flesh shall see it together: for the mouth of the LORD hath spoken it."

There is no doubt about it God will reveal his Glory. All flesh shall see it because God has said it, and it must happen, now in this generation.

Isaiah 60:1-3

1: "Arise, shine; for thy light is come, and the glory of the LORD is risen upon thee.

2: For, behold, the darkness shall cover the earth, and gross darkness the people: but the LORD shall arise upon thee, and his glory shall be seen upon thee.

3: And the Gentiles shall come to thy light, and kings to the brightness of thy rising."

The Light is here, its time to arise. Risen means '**shoot forth as beams**'.

A time is coming and very soon when people will see beams of Light break forth on Gods people.

We are living in a time of gross darkness; the earth is covered in this darkness.

But don't worry about the darkness, for when the light is turned on the darkness will disappear.

The world will see the light. Gentiles means 'the nations', the Glory is not for the few but for the many. Every nation will see the Glory of Gods latter day church.

2 Corinthians 3:18

"But we all, with open face beholding as in a glass the glory of the Lord, are changed into the same image from glory to glory, even as by the Spirit of the Lord."

Do you want to be so changed that you reveal Gods Glory? As we behold Him, and spending time in His presence, that transformation will come, from Glory to Glory.

The Coming Flood Of Gods Power

I don't believe that there has ever been a time in the history of the human race naturally speaking, when there as been more problems than today. Lets list some of them:

September 11th, and terror attacks. The almost certain prospect of war with Iraq. The possible use of weapons of mass destruction, by terrorists or rogue states, such as North Korea.

Not only these, but there is the growing problem of drug addiction and trafficking. The break down of the family unit, which is the building block of all society, including the Church. Abortion. I could go on and on, but I am sure that you get the picture.

Now for the Good News.

Isaiah 59:19

"When the enemy shall come in, like a flood the Spirit of the LORD shall lift up a standard against him. KJV

When the enemy shall come in, like a flood the Spirit of the LORD shall make him flee". Modern King James.

It may seem that the enemy is coming in like a flood, but on the basis of Gods Word, I can tell you that the flood is not caused by the enemy, and his attempts to "Steal, Kill and Destroy"(John 10:10). The flood comes in response to Satan's attacks, the flood is the Spirit of God raising up an all-powerful standard.

The Spirit is not the standard, but the Spirit does raise it up. One of the meanings of the Word Standard is 'A Weight or Measure to which all others of the same type must conform'.

Who or what is Gods end-time standard?

Ephesians 4:11-15

11 And truly He gave some to be apostles, and some to be prophets, and some to be evangelists, and some to be pastors and teachers,

12 for the perfecting of the saints, for the work of the ministry, for the edifying of the body of Christ.

13 And this until we all come into the unity of the faith and of the knowledge of the Son of God, to a full-grown man, to the measure of the stature of the fullness of Christ;

14 so that we no longer may be infants, tossed to and fro and carried about by every wind of doctrine, in the dishonesty of men, in cunning craftiness, to the wiles of deceit. 15 But that you, speaking the truth in love, may in all things grow up to Him who is the Head, even Christ;

Gods Standard is "A full-grown man, to the measure of the stature of the fullness of Christ;" Verse 13 and Those of His body, who have "grown up into the Head, even Christ;" Verse 15.

Stature means according to Strongs (2244) "Maturity in age, or years" this word comes from another Greek root word (2245) meaning "As big as". The dictionary says 'stature' comes originally from a word, which means, "To stand".

Not all born-again, Spirit filled Christians, will be part of this Standard body. Only those who choose "to grow up into Him who is the head" Ephesians 4:15. Most will not make that choice.

Jesus was Gods pattern son, the prototype, but this end-time body of believers, made up of many members, will be the first fruits of the end-time harvest, His body in the earth, perfect and complete, walking in the fullness of the life Jesus had.

John 12:28-32

28 Father, glorify Your name! Then there came a voice from the heaven saying, I have both glorified it and will glorify it again.

29 Then the crowd who stood by and heard said that it thundered. Others said, An angel spoke to Him.

30 Jesus answered and said, This voice did not come because of Me, but for your sakes.

31 Now is the judgement of this world. Now shall the prince of this world be cast out.

32 And I, if I am lifted up from the earth, I will draw all to Myself.

Notice the words "I have both glorified it (Gods name) and will glorify it again" v28. Yes the first glorification was when Jesus died, and rose again, defeating Satan in hell itself. But these verses say that He will glorify His name again, but the question is when?

When He raises up His end-time standard, who will fully enforce the victory that Jesus won on the cross. The Church has never walked in the fullness of the finished work of Christ. But His standard, those in the end-time Church, who are His standard, will see a flood of Gods power released from them, power to enforce His victory.

Isaiah 49:22

22 Thus saith the Lord GOD, Behold, I will lift up mine hand to the Gentiles, and set up my standard to the people: and they shall bring thy sons in their arms, and thy daughters shall be carried upon their shoulders.

God says "I will lift up mine hand to the Gentiles". The hand in prophecy speaks of and is a type of the service of the Five Fold ministry that Jesus has set in His Church.

Gentiles is the Hebrew word for Nations, His standard will have world wide impact, turning the nations upside down, or is it right side up? The impact of the standard will produce "sons and daughters", the end-time manifestation of Gods Sons. (Romans 8:14-23)

Isaiah 62: 10-12

10 Go through, go through the gates; prepare ye the way of the people; cast up, cast up the highway; gather out the stones; lift up a standard for the people.

11 Behold, the LORD hath proclaimed unto the end of the world, Say ye to the daughter of Zion, Behold, thy salvation cometh; behold, his reward is with him, and his work before him.

12 And they shall call them, The holy people, The redeemed of the LORD: and thou shalt be called, Sought out, A city not forsaken.

The task of the Gods end-time standard is to "Gather out the stones" v10. Who are these Stones? 1 Peter 2:4,5 says " For having been drawn to Him, a living Stone, indeed rejected by men, but elect, precious with God; You also as living stones are built up a spiritual house, a holy priesthood, to offer up spiritual sacrifices acceptable to God through Jesus Christ".

Notice also the standard is to be called by all "The holy people", the same words are used in 1 Peter 2:9:

"But ye are a chosen generation, a royal priesthood, an holy nation, a peculiar people; that ye should show forth the praises of him who hath called you out of darkness into his marvellous light".

Nation is the same word used in Isaiah for People.

Another task of Gods standard is to speak to 'The Daughters of Zion', or the Church. The Church by and large has rejected every move of God, since the time of Martin Luther. God has done a new thing in the earth every 50 years, but by and large it has been rejected by the main line established churches.

What is the standard to say to the daughters of Zion? "Behold, thy salvation cometh; behold, his reward is with him, and his work before him". Yes Salvation is coming. Obadiah 1:21 says of Gods end-time standard.

Obadiah 1:21

21 And saviours shall come up on mount Zion to judge the mount of Esau; and the kingdom shall be the LORD'S.

Yes salvation will come when His standard is raised like a mighty flood that the spirit of God will blow.

The Bible in Basic English translates Isaiah 59:19 this way:

19 So they will see the name of the Lord from the west, and his glory from the east: for he will come like a rushing stream, forced on by a wind of the Lord. (BBE)

Isaiah 59:19

19 So shall they fear the name of the LORD from the west, and his glory from the rising of the sun. When the enemy shall come in, like a flood the Spirit of the LORD shall lift up a standard against him.

Joel 2:28-32

28 And it shall come to pass afterward, that I will pour out my spirit upon all flesh; and your sons and your daughters shall prophesy, your old men shall dream dreams, your young men shall see visions:

29 And also upon the servants and upon the handmaids in those days will I pour out my spirit.

30 And I will show wonders in the heavens and in the earth, blood, and fire, and pillars of smoke.

31 The sun shall be turned into darkness, and the moon into blood, before the great and the terrible day of the LORD come.

32 And it shall come to pass, that whosoever shall call on the name of the LORD shall be delivered: for in mount Zion and in Jerusalem shall be deliverance, as the LORD hath said, and in the remnant whom the LORD shall call.

In verse 32 Gods end-time standard is referred to as 'The remnant', a remnant is a piece of cloth at the end of the roll that appears to be of no use, because it is too small. However Joseph's coat of many colours was in fact a coat of many pieces! God can make something useful out of what the world and the church considers useless. The remnant will be made up of ordinary people, humble people, with little natural ability, people who must rely on God for all that they do, people who will allow God to move through them, and not let self get in the way.

John7: 37-39

37 In the last day, that great day of the feast, Jesus stood and cried, saying, If any man thirst, let him come unto me, and drink.

38 He that believeth on me, as the scripture hath said, out of his belly shall flow rivers of living water.

39 (But this spake he of the Spirit, which they that believe on him should receive: for the Holy Ghost was not yet given; because that Jesus was not yet glorified.)

The last Great day when Jesus cried out these words, was the last day of their Feast of tabernacles. However I believe that these verses have a fulfilment today for we are living in the last days. When many rivers flow together and at the same time, what you get is a flood.

The word 'Flow' is an interesting word; the Greek word (Strong's 4482) is 'Rheo' from which we get our word 'Rhetoric'. Rhetoric has to do with words, what comes out of the Belly or Heat of Gods end-time remnant and standard are words, not some mystical spiritual force, but anointed words of power, creative words, life producing words, Gods Word.

Habakkuk 2:14

14 For the earth shall be filled with the knowledge of the glory of the LORD, as the waters cover the sea. {With... or, by knowing the glory}

Isaiah 11: 9

9 They shall not hurt nor destroy in all my holy mountain: for the earth shall be full of the knowledge of the LORD, as the waters cover the sea.

The word 'Knowledge' can also be translated 'Acknowledge' (Strong's 1844). How will the world acknowledge the fact of Gods glory filling the earth, if no one tells them?

I am reminded of the words of Jesus, in Luke 10: 2 "Therefore said he unto them, the harvest truly is great, but the labourers are few: pray ye therefore the Lord of the harvest, that he would send forth labourers into his harvest".

The type of the feast of Tabernacles, will be fulfilled by His end-time standard. It is harvest time the seed as been planted, and the grain is already ripe. The word Labours means (Strong's 2040-204) "A toiler, A Teacher, Labourer, Worker or Workman".

Matthew 28:19

19 Go ye therefore, and teach all nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father, and of the Son, and of the Holy Ghost:

20 Teaching them to observe all things whatsoever I have commanded you: and, lo, I am with you always even unto the end of the world. Amen. (KJV)

I know that one of the Five-Fold ministry is the teacher, but Jesus said that we are all to teach. It's not in natural availability but by his Spirit, as we let the words that He gives from our spirit. God's end-time standard will fulfil great commission.

The early Church began to walk in this. Acts 1:4 "These all continued with one accord in prayer and supplication, with the women, and Mary the mother of Jesus, and with his brethren". Acts 2:1 "And when the day of Pentecost was fully come, they were all with one accord in one place".

The key words in those verses are "In one Accord" Strong's translates this as "Of one mind", but the English word 'Accord' is from the Latin word meaning 'Heart' or 'spirit'. Yes they were of one mind but the key to the outpouring in the Book of Acts, is that they were all of one spirit and recognised this to be a fact. Today many Christians are gathered together, in the great and grand buildings, which we call Churches, but how many are of one spirit, one heart, one mind and one soul?

I believe that the vision that God gave to Ezekiel of the dry bones (read Ezekiel chapter 37) is for us today. The Church by and large is dead, just like Ezekiel's dry bones. How often do we see the dead raised, the lame walk, the blind to see and the deaf to hear, yes we may see them in special services and great conventions, but these things should be commonplace among us.

God's solution was for Ezekiel to prophesy over the dry bones. The word Prophecy used here does not mean 'Foretell', but 'Flow out'. God wanted Ezekiel to release the Life giving water from within him. That's the only answer for the lifeless Church today, a people who are willing to give themselves, to let Him flow through them, bring life where there is only death.

Everywhere that the river touches it brings Life, Ezekiel's bones became a mighty army, because Ezekiel was faithful. God wants to raise up a mighty army of Ezekiel's today. He wants to see the flood of life that is locked up within His people flow out, in words of power, might and anointing.

What is the reason for this end time out pouring? Matthew 16:18 tell us "Upon this rock I will build my church; and the gates of hell shall not prevail against it".

You know the religious mind, read this verse the opposite way round, we are the ones who prevail, and we are the winners. Prevail means 'Hold out'. Most Christians see themselves as being 'prevailed over by Satan' I have got news for you we prevail over him. The gates of Hell will not hold out against His end-time standard. In fact Jesus has already won the victory, He defeated the devil, in hell itself He prevailed. He has the keys to death and hell, and has given them to His Church.

Christ the Rock

Numbers 20:7-11

7 And the LORD spake unto Moses, saying,
8 Take the rod, and gather thou the assembly together, thou, and Aaron thy brother, and speak ye unto the rock before their eyes; and it shall give forth water, and thou shalt bring forth to them water out of the rock: so thou shalt give the congregation and their beasts drink. 9 And Moses took the rod from before the LORD, as he commanded him. 10 And Moses and Aaron gathered the congregation together before the rock, and he said unto them, Hear now, ye rebels; must we fetch you water out of this rock?
11 And Moses lifted up his hand, and with his rod he smote the rock twice: and the water came out abundantly, and the congregation drank, and their beasts also.

Over 2 million people drank from that one rock, plus there live stock, and there was water over to water their crops, there must have been water over to water their crops. But this rock in the wilderness was only a type of the Rock who was to come.

1 Corinthians 10:1-4

1 Moreover, brethren, I would not that ye should be ignorant, how that all our fathers were under the cloud, and all passed through the sea;
2 And were all baptised unto Moses in the cloud and in the sea;
3 And did all eat the same spiritual meat;
4 And did all drink the same spiritual drink: for they drank of that spiritual Rock that followed them: and that Rock was Christ.

In the Greek 'Followed' reads 'Went with them', everywhere they went the rock went. Everywhere that you go, today, the rock goes. The Rock is Christ, and Christ is in you. In the natural or supernatural rock there was enough water to give 2 Million people to drink.

Christ is not the surname of Jesus. Christ means "The anointed, Anointed One or just plain Anointing". If you are in Christ you have this anointing, its part of your nature. Colossians 1: 27 says of us "Christ in you, the hope of glory".

What is this Glory, which is in us? It's the flood that Isaiah said would flow from the end-time Church.

Isaiah 59:19

19 So shall they fear the name of the LORD from the west, and his glory from the rising of the sun. When the enemy shall come in, like a flood the Spirit of the LORD shall lift up a standard against him.

The words "Lift Up" in the Hebrew also mean 'put him to flight'. Yes hell is going to fall, it cannot hold out against the flood power of God's end-time standard. God is going to prove to this generation who He really is and that He is very much alive and living through a people. A people who the world system does not recognise, who the system hates.

Isaiah 59:19 "When the enemy shall come in like a flood, the Spirit of the LORD shall lift up a standard against him"

The coming of the latter rain.

Joel 2:23

23 Be glad then, ye children of Zion, and rejoice in the LORD your God: for he hath given you the former rain moderately, and he will cause to come down for you the rain, the former rain, and the latter rain in the first month.

Everything God did in the past, the mighty works of the Old Testament prophets, the mighty outpouring on the early Church in the book of Acts, and even the modern pentecostal/Charismatic movements, is all part of the former rain.

God is going to send the latter rain in this generation, the Latter Rain Revival of 1947, was I believe a down payment; a forerunner of what God is going to do today. The Former Rain only came Moderately, or in small measure, why was that? It was because the Church was not yet ready for the outpouring.

Moderately in the Hebrew reading of this verse says "According to Righteousness", before our generation, the Church and most individuals in it, did not have a knowledge of there Righteous standing as Sons of God. However one of the things that the Latter Rain revival restored, was the teaching of the fact that we are made right by the death, burial and resurrection of Jesus Christ, and the fact that He exchanged His righteous nature for our sin nature.

2 Corinthians 5:17-21

17 Therefore if any man be in Christ, he is a new creature: old things are passed away; behold, all things are become new. 18 And all things are of God, who hath reconciled us to himself by Jesus Christ, and hath given to us the ministry of reconciliation; 19 To wit, that God was in Christ, reconciling the world unto himself, not imputing their trespasses unto them; and hath committed unto us the word of reconciliation. Rom 3:24-25,20 Now then we are ambassadors for Christ, as though God did beseech you by us: we pray you in Christ's stead, be ye reconciled to God. 21 For he hath made him to be sin for us, who knew no sin; that we might be made the righteousness of God in him.

"The former rain moderately" reads in the Hebrew Margin "A teacher of Righteousness" or we could say "The Teaching of Righteousness".

Most Christians think of themselves as "Sinners Saved by Grace", you are not a sinner saved by grace, Gods Word says that you are "The righteousness of God in Christ". Even that does not plum the depths of what He did for us in Christ, because the Greek says in verse 17, we are: New Creations, or "A New Species". In truth we did not really exist before we were born-again, because we were dead in our Spirits. But now 1 Corinthians 6:17 says that "But he that is joined unto the Lord is one spirit". Not One in Spirit, But "One new Spirit"! God's Spirit fuses with our New Born Human Spirit to become one new entity Now that the former rain has fell, or that the teaching of the fact of our Righteous standing has been restored to the Church, even though most Christians fail to believe that they are righteous. God is now today, in this generation going to send the flood tide of the Latter rain.

We will not only see this rain, but we will see the harvest brought in. The harvest is ready; the fields are already white with the ripened grain.

What will this outpouring belike? God is going to manifest His Glory through His body in the earth. John 17:22 says "And the Glory which thou gavest me I have given them; that they may be one, even as we are one".

Jesus did not give us the Glory so that it would remain in us, but so that it would be seen in us and flow out of us. God wants to live through us, and for us to live as Jesus lived.

Haggai 2:7-9

7 And I will shake all nations, and the desire of all nations shall come: and I will fill this house with glory, saith the LORD of hosts. 8 The silver is mine, and the gold is mine, saith the LORD of hosts. 9 The glory of this latter house shall be greater than the former, saith the LORD of hosts:

and in this place will I give peace, saith the LORD of hosts.

The former house was The Tabernacle and latter the Temple where glory dwelt, the glory was so heavy in the Temple that the priests were unable to minister. We are the Latter House God's Glory is within us.

2 Corinthians 4:7

7 But we have this treasure in earthen vessels, that the excellency of the power may be of God, and not of us.

You are that walking, talking Glory of God. Everywhere you go His Glory goes. Every time you speak in line with His Word, that is the Glory speaking.

Isaiah 4:5

5 And the LORD will create upon every dwelling place of mount Zion, and upon her assemblies, a cloud and smoke by day, and the shining of a flaming fire by night: for upon all the glory shall be a defence

Mount Zion is not some mountain in the Middle East, that was a type of the end-time mount Zion. We the Church are spiritual Mount Zion.

Galatians 4:22-26

22 For it is written, that Abraham had two sons, the one by a bondmaid, the other by a freewoman. 23 But he who was of the bondwoman was born after the flesh; but he of the freewoman was by promise. 24 Which things are an allegory: for these are the two covenants; the one from the mount Sinai, which gendereth to bondage, which is Agar. 25 For this Agar is mount Sinai in Arabia, and answereth to Jerusalem which now is, and is in bondage with her children. {Answereth to: or, is in the same rank with} 26 But Jerusalem which is above is free, which is the mother of us all.

We, Gods Church, are Jerusalem, which is above, the New Jerusalem and Mount Zion. God Says that He is going to "Create upon every dwelling place of mount Zion, and upon her assemblies, a cloud and smoke by day, and the shining of a flaming fire by night: for upon all the glory shall be a defence".

The word Defence in Hebrew means 'Covering', There is a lot of teaching in the Church today about covering, and the idea that some man needs to cover you! Ministers of the gospel go around asking each other "who is your covering?" Well I have got news for you, if I have Gods Glory cover-

ing me, I do not need a man to cover me, whatever title he may have.

The Pillar of Fire and the Cloud of smoke was how God manifest himself to the Children of Israel in the wilderness, God says that it is coming again, He is going to manifest Himself by placing, the Glory cloud and the pillar of fire upon every dwelling place in Zion. Where does God dwell today? In Us!

The Glory that was reflected on the face of Moses, the Glory that the disciples saw Jesus transfigured into. That same Glory will be seen in and upon Gods end-time Church. His Glory is already in us. He wants that same glory to flow out of us, bringing life to all that it touches.

God wants the entire world to know who He is and who we are, His family, His children, His flesh and bones.

Habakkuk 2:14

14 For the earth shall be filled with the knowledge of the glory of the LORD, as the waters cover the sea.

The Hebrew margin says that the earth will be filled, "By knowing the Glory" then God's Glory manifests through His end-time Church, His Sons, everyone will know it. The largest of mans Church will not be able to hold the crowds of people coming to be taught, people of every race, every nation, men, women and children.

What is the Key to releasing this flood tide of Glory?

Psalms 50:23

23 Whoso offereth praise glorifieth me: and to him that ordereth his conversation aright will I shew the salvation of God.

Praise releases God's Glory into the earth! How do we order your conversation aright? By always speaking words of praise.

What is salvation referring to here? It is a salvation that can be seen, a salvation that is manifest in a visible and tangible way.

When we speak about God's Glory, when we sing about God's Glory, I believe that we will see it. But we must firmly believe with every part of our being since the glory is in us, and is about to be seen by the world. God's Word says Colossians 1:27 " To whom God would make known what is the riches of the glory of this mystery among the Gentiles; which

is Christ in you, the hope of glory". The word Hope means "Joyful expectation".

Psalm 22:3

3 But thou art holy, O thou that inhabitest the praises of Israel. (KJV)
And you are holy, who dwells amid the praises of Israel. (DBY)

God lives, God Comes alive in our praises. You may ask "Isn't God here all the time"? Yes He is, but inhabit does not mean to come to visit now and again, inhabit means 'To dwell permanently in'. The more time that we spend in praise, the more we will see His Glory manifest.

Exodus 15:2

2 The LORD is my strength and song, and He is become my salvation: He is my God, and I will prepare him an habitation; my father's God, and I will exalt him. (KJV)

2 The LORD is my strength and song, and He has become my salvation. He is my God, and I will glorify Him, my father's God, and I will exalt Him. (MKJV)

Did you notice how "Prepare Him an inhabitation"; in the King James is translated "I will glorify Him" in the Modern King James? Is one translation right and the other wrong? No both are in the Hebrew! When we praise Him, He feels at home. You may be Born-again and Spirit filled, but if you do not praise Him, He will not feel at home in you. There is a vast difference between a house and a home.

God is ready to pour out of His Glory, in the greatest flood of Holy Ghost power this world as ever known. God is not looking for natural ability. He is looking for faithfulness and dedication.

I am firmly persuaded that many mighty men of today, will not be in this move of God's Glory. Every 50 years since the time of Martin Luther, there has been a fresh move of God, yet the leaders of the past move have always rejected it.

This move I believe will be from among small groups of Christians, ordinary people, humble people, people who will allow God to move without getting in His way. People who will not want to build up their own kingdoms and organisations. People who will only give God the glory. I do not know about you, but I am committed to being part of the mighty standard that God is going to raise in these last days.
